Abstract guidelines

Deadlines

To be reviewed by the scientific committee, all abstracts must be submitted no later than

Friday April 3, 2020

(Submissions of late abstracts after this date is at the organizer's discretion and will be for a poster only)

Authors of accepted abstracts will be notified by the end of April 24, 2020. Please do not enquire about the status of your abstract before this as a decision will not have been made. Oral presentations will be awarded on merit to the best abstracts as decided by the Scientific Committee.

All accepted abstracts will be invited to be presented as either a 10 minute oral presentation or a poster at the conference. You will be notified of which with your acceptance and presentation or poster guidelines will be provided. Those invited to give an oral presentation will be asked to provide further details (photo, biography, summary of work) for the program.

There will be a dedicated poster viewing session on the evening of May 27, 2020. Oral presentations will take place during the main conference program on May 28-29, 2020

Abstract format:

- Abstracts must be submitted as a Word document.
- Word count: Maximum 250 words
- Font: Calibri 11
- Spacing: 1.5 lines
- Language: English

Abstract Content:

- The abstract must be a new theory clearly state: **Objective, Method, Results & Conclusions**
- The abstract should have clear scientific evidence, and be devoid of commercial bias
- The abstract should highlight the relevance to the theme(s) of this years conference
- Please provide full contact details for the corresponding lead author
- Nonstandard abbreviations should be defined.
- Clinical abstracts & titles must conform to CONSORT guidelines
- Abstracts containing clinical trials must have gone through an evaluation by an ethical committee. Trial registration number and review board details must be provided on the abstract

It is the author's responsibility to submit a correct abstract. Any errors in spelling, grammar or scientific fact in the abstract text will be reproduced as typed by the author.

Any abstracts not conforming to the above parameters will be rejected.

Please state when submitting your abstract if you only wish to be considered for a poster.

By submitting abstracts you are granting permission for your abstract to be reviewed by the scientific committee and published in any or all of the following – conference material and website; NutraIngredients-USA and other William Reed Business Media sites; IPA publications and publications of event media partners.
